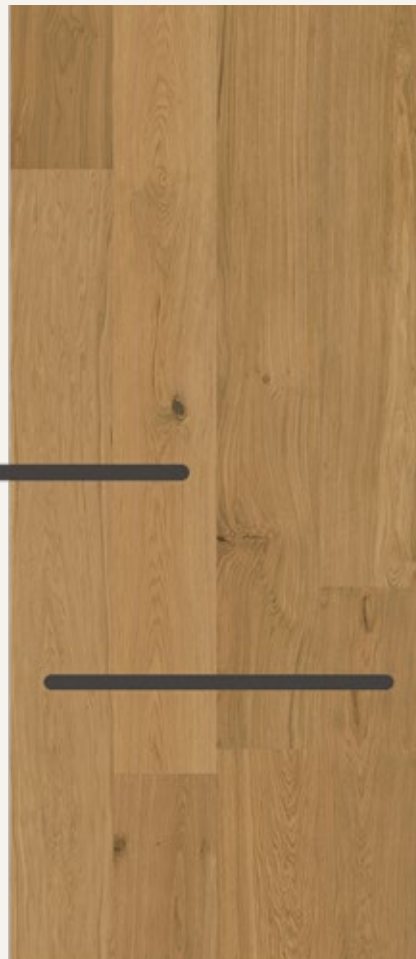

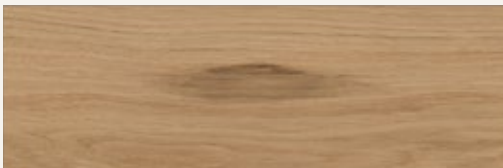
Opened and closed knots, cat paw and cracks in the surface are not product defects and in no way compromise the quality or durability of our wood flooring. Likewise, medullary rays,

colour variations and mineral streaks are unique features that embrace nature's uniqueness and beauty. These expected imperfections maintain the depth and personality of our wood flooring.

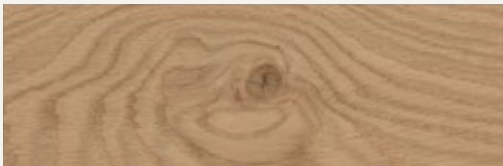

The natural beauty of oak colour variations

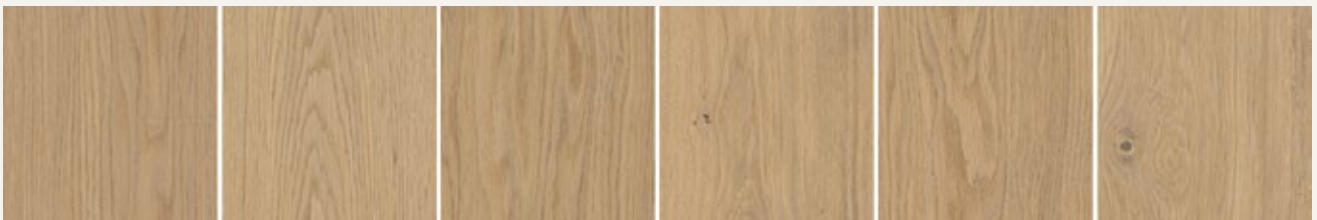

The beautiful spectrum of ash wood colours

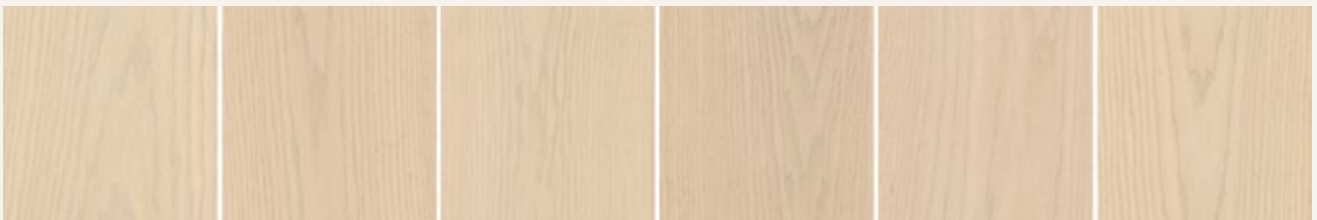
